Allight's new lighting tower to make Australian debut at Kalgoorlie's GME

Allight will display its new Nightshifter6000 mobile lighting tower for the first time in Australia on **Stand 2456** during the Goldfields Mining Expo (GME) at the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Racing Club from October 28-30, 2008.

The Australian-engineered Nightshifter6000 is designed to provide a crossover between Allight's Mine Spec mining and Urban mobile lighting tower ranges and has already been exported to the United States.

The 6000th Mine Spec tower, a MineSpec 12K-10 weighing 2.tonnes, was recently produced.

The Nightshifter6000 has a Mine Spec chassis, high wall capabilities and a compact mast design. It can be economically transported across long distances with one 40' flatbed truck or cargo container able to transport up to eight towers.

The towers can also be licensed for road travel and are easily towed.

The Nightshifter6000 features an integrated control panel for hydraulic light tilting, and mast raising and extension.

Lighting direction can be readily controlled with mast rotation of 350° while the mast is fully extended and 120° two-way light tilt.

Hydraulic mast rotation and hydraulic stabiliser legs are also available.
